ENGLAND V GHANA

The Three Lions face a crucial second group match against a dangerous Ghana side, with major implications for both teams' tournament prospects. England boast a high-quality squad led by captain Harry Kane, supported by world-class talents including Bukayo Saka, Declan Rice, Jude Bellingham and Phil Foden, alongside impressive depth throughout the team. Ghana are also well equipped, featuring Premier League standouts Antoine Semenyo and Mohammed Kudus, former Arsenal midfielder Thomas Partey, and La Liga star Iñaki Williams. With so much at stake on the biggest stage in international football, this promises to be a compelling contest!

TEDDY SHERINGHAM

Teddy Sheringham enjoyed an outstanding 25-year career at the highest level, making almost 1,000 club and international appearances and scoring over 350 goals. A prolific striker, he won the Premier League Golden Boot in the inaugural 1992–93 season before enjoying major success at Manchester United, where he won three Premier League titles, the FA Cup, and played a pivotal role in the club's historic 1999 treble, scoring a dramatic equaliser in the Champions League final and then assisting the winning goal. A true Tottenham Hotspur legend, Sheringham scored 125 goals in 277 appearances across two spells at White Hart Lane. He also earned 51 England caps, forming a memorable partnership with Alan Shearer during Euro '96 as England reached the semi-finals.



NICKY BUTT

Nicky Butt was a key figure in one of English football's most successful eras, earning 39 caps for England and playing an integral role in Manchester United's iconic "Class of '92" under Sir Alex Ferguson. Renowned for his tenacity, intelligence, and control of midfield battles, he made over 380 appearances for United, winning six Premier League titles, three FA Cups, and the UEFA Champions League in 1999. He later enjoyed a distinguished spell with Newcastle United, captaining the club and surpassing 100 Premier League appearances, before finishing his playing career with Birmingham City. After retiring, Nicky moved into coaching and leadership, returning to Manchester United as Head of Academy, where he helped develop the club's next generation.

DAVID JAMES

David enjoyed a remarkable 26-year career, earning 53 caps for England and establishing himself as one of the country's most consistent goalkeepers. He made 958 club appearances, including 572 in the Premier League — the highest total for a goalkeeper — representing Watford, Liverpool, Aston Villa, West Ham, Manchester City, and Portsmouth. David won the League Cup with Liverpool in 1994/95 and famously lifted the FA Cup with Portsmouth in 2007/08. As England's first-choice goalkeeper during Euro 2004 and the 2010 World Cup, he was a commanding presence on the international stage. Appointed MBE in 2012, David continues to support young people through his foundation and remains a popular speaker.
