▶ Stadium Entrance

The Commonwealth Bar is accessed via the East Stand reception.

▶ Payments

Cashless, card payments only.

▶ Alcohol

Club may refuse service to intoxicated guests; responsible behavior required.

Valid ticket required for entry; no re-entry permitted.

► **Dress Code**

► **Fixture Changes**

Dates/times may change (e.g., for TV); bookings non-refundable/non-cancellable.
